What is the Carnet de Passages en Douane?

The CPD is a customs facilitation document used to cover the temporary importation of road motor vehicles.

The CPD constitutes an international guarantee that customs duties and taxes will be paid if a customs claim arises due to the non-re-exportation of a vehicle.

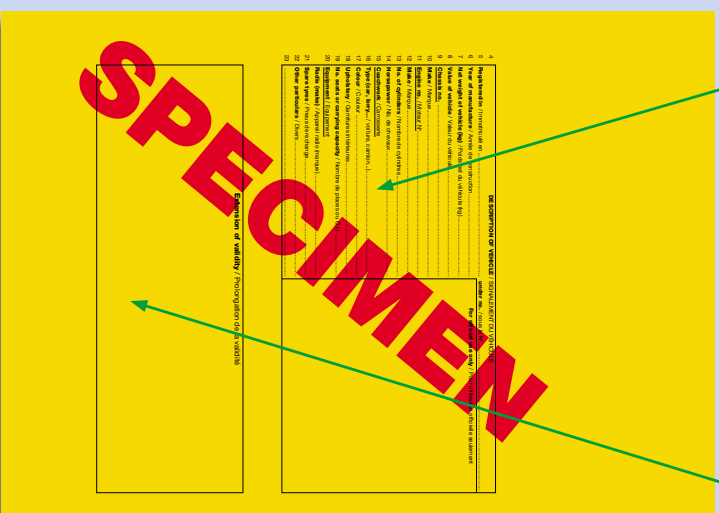

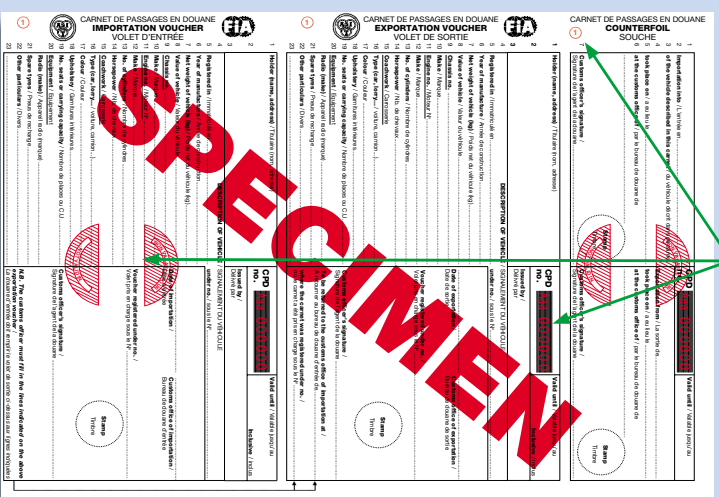
